National Conference attracted 199 delegates to Samuel Marsden Collegiate School from 5-7 July 2010. The three day programme included 63 presentations undertaken by over 70 presenters in addition to the three keynote presentations undertaken by guests Stuart Middleton, Kirsten Petrie and Yvette McCausland-Durie. On Tuesday we welcomed 19 Physical Education stalwarts of the past to the President's Luncheon. A feature of Conference 2010 was the inclusion of a Primary Level strand that stretched throughout the three days while there was a significant increase in teachers from throughout New Zealand running workshops in which they shared good practice in physical education with colleagues, something called for in 2009 and well received by all. Two new Board Members

(report follows) were elected at the AGM held at Mac's Brewery that also served as the venue for the Welcome Reception. A highlight of Conference was the awards ceremony that culminated in Professor Bevan Grant receiving the Sir Alexander Gillies Medal for outstanding service to Physical Education. Delegates excelled themselves in their "School Uniform" at the Conference Dinner held at The Ruby Lounge. One interesting theme was the relationship between Physical Education and sport within New Zealand schools. This topic was touched on by John Reid, General Manager of Community Sport and Recreation (SPARC) during his opening address with further insights coming from Clive Pope and Garry Carnachan. Conference evaluations revealed appreciation for Conference programme content and satisfaction with the catering and social programme. Cold rooms, limited indoor seating and bus transport are conference components to improve in the future. Conference Committee members are sincerely thanked for their commitment while Pasgaard Sports Distributors and Conference Bronze Sponsors, VX Sport and St John are thanked for their invaluable financial contributions that made Conference possible.

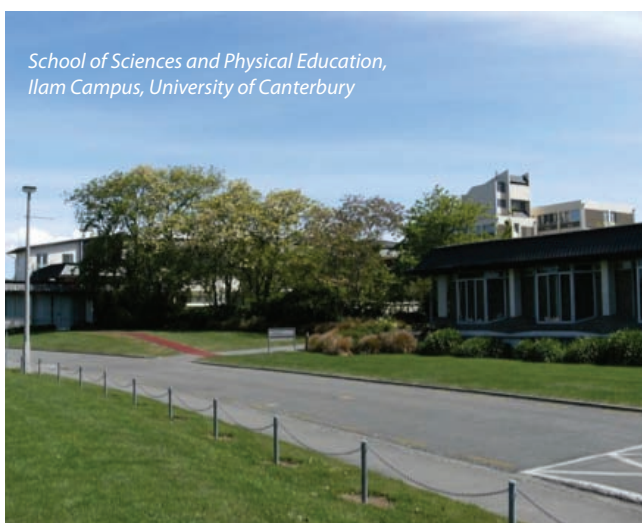

Alignment of standards with the New Zealand Curriculum:

Level 2 - Consultation

The Ministry of Education has contracted Research New Zealand to carry out consultation with users of unit and achievement standards derived from the school curriculum. A significant programme has been conducted by the Ministry, with NZQA, to re-write these standards so that they align with the revised New Zealand Curriculum (2007), address parity issues and remove duplication. This consultation covers draft Level 2 standards. Level 3 standards will be issued for consultation in 2011.

Standards for each subject The Ministry and NZQA have worked with subject specialists to provide a draft of the revised matrix for the standards in each subject, along with a rationale for the changes proposed, and information on the changes proposed to existing curriculum derived unit and achievement standards. Note that NZQA unit standards that are not derived from the New Zealand Curriculum, and ITO standards, are not part of this process. As well, for each subject there are draft standards at Level 2 for consultation, and conditions of assessment for internally assessed standards. **Consultation Process** Research New Zealand have set up a web site for online consultation. We encourage online responses to be made, but paper submissions will also be accepted. This consultation will close on **Sunday 26th September 2010**. Your response to the proposals is important. We encourage you to give reasons for your responses, because these provide a valuable context for the Ministry to consider how changes should be made to the draft standards.
