Introducing Trevor Garrett – PENZ Patron

PENZ is pleased to announce the appointment of Trevor Garrett as PENZ Patron at the recently held PENZ AGM.

In the words of Bob Stothart "Trevor is one of us. He studied Physical Education at the School of Physical Education, University of Otago before teaching at Te Aroha College, Marcellin College and Dilworth College in Auckland. He then took off to the University of Indiana to do a Masters degree in Recreation Administration. On his return to New Zealand Trevor secured a job with the newly established Ministry of Recreation and Sport and began an impressive career in the public service, in the Department of Internal Affairs. Initially he was an Advisory Officer in Recreation later becoming Chief Executive Officer for Recreation and Sport. In this role he worked closely with politicians, including Ministers of the Crown, and with local body politicians and a vast array of national recreation and sports organisations. This is a field he knows extremely well.

Trevor found time during his busy schedule to serve as the President of NZAHPER on two occasions (1980 to 1983 and 1985 to 1986), and to play competitive hockey and golf; to ski and to run. He has never lost his kinesthetic urge to be engaged in

physical activity but has added cooking and reading to his current list of interests. Opportunities to contribute in University programmes presented themselves at Lincoln University, Victoria University and at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. Trevor also maintained his academic curiosity gaining a Master of Public Policy from Victoria University and attending the prestigious Senior Management Program at the John F Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University.

In recent times Trevor has been Chief Executive of the Casino Control Authority, a job that saw him consulting around the world as various countries became engaged in similar activities. Trevor is currently, Chief Executive Officer of the recently formed Charities Commission. In 2010 Trevor was inducted to the Wall of Fame at the School of Physical Education.

FELLOW AWARDS

TE IHO-TAKARO RINGAWERA AWARD

PENZ newest Award, the Te Iho-Takaro Ringawera Award was introduced by PENZ Board Member responsible for Maori Representation, Harko Brown. Harko explained that "Iho-Takaro" refers to the 'essence' of physical movement as in "the intrinsic or indispensable properties that serve to characterize or identify something." Harko added that "in Maori culture the most respected work is done by 'Ringawera'." This award is therefore intended to commend service that is considered to be at the highest level, something one might describe as "gold nuggets" to the fraternity. Congratulations to the first recipient of this Award, Life Member Bob Stothart who continues to make an invaluable contribution to PENZ projects, often in relative obscurity. Recipients will hold the trophy for twelve months with their name being recorded on the Honours Board.

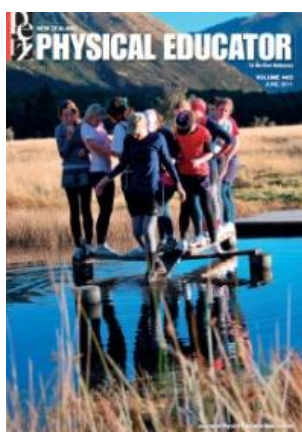

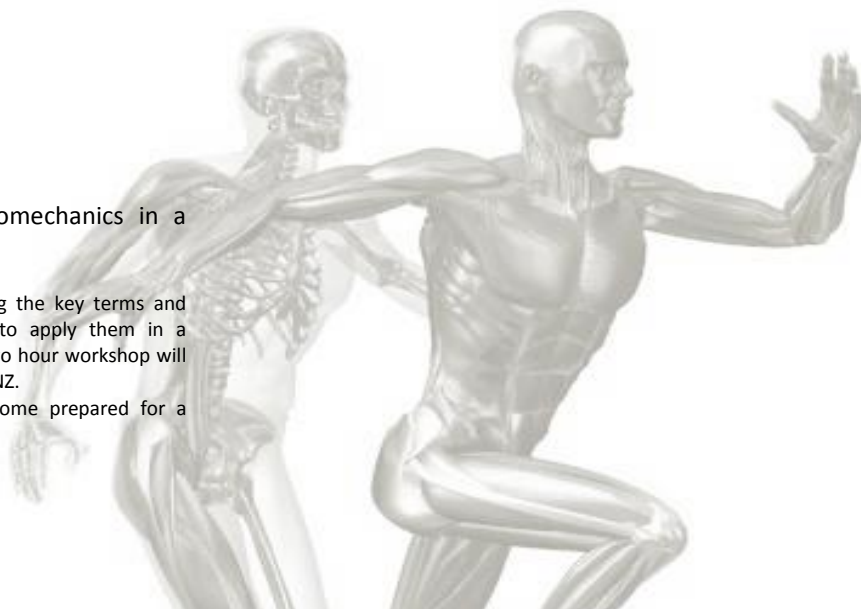

Workshop places will be allocated on a strictly first-in-first-served basis. In the event that space is unavailable you will be notified immediately. Workshop fees are payable in advance of attendance.

If for some reason a registrant is unable to attend a workshop, another person may be substituted; alternatively the registration may be transferred to another available workshop.

Where a registrant is unable to attend, and is not in a position to transfer his/her place to another person or to another event, then the following refund arrangements apply. Generally, 7days notice is required for a full refund or credit. Cancellations notified within 48 hours, a 50% refund will be offered. Cancellations within 24hours, or without notice, no refund will be offered.
