## Summit Group Update

PENZ hosted another summit meeting between the universities. The group met at Victoria University in Wellington to discuss progress made on a project aimed at improving initial teacher education for the delivery of quality Physical Education at primary level. All seven universities were represented and a proposal was tabled to establish the group as PENZ University Advisory Committee.

The group received feedback on other subject areas that are similarly concerned about the loss of time and subject-specific focus on teacher education programmes. Approaches made to the Ministry of Education revealed that the present focus remains confined to numeracy, literacy, national standards, Maori and Pasifika. PENZ remains extremely concerned about the quality of teacher education for primary teachers and the impact this has on the provision of quality physical education in primary schools.

On a different front, it would seem that the project will be strongly supported by a wide range of sport organisations. Letters of support will be sought from a range of sports bodies and an approach will be made to the new government after the election.

# Expedition Challenge – A LEARNZ Virtual Field Trip

**21-25 November 2011**

Expedition Challenge is a SPARC funded LEARNZ Virtual Field trip targeting Physical Education, Outdoor Education and Social Studies at years 3-10. In a LEARNZ field trip students stay at school but prepare themselves and participate in the trip through the internet. Expedition Challenge will inspire and motivate students to want to create their own outdoor adventures, safely.
